



## **Randy Rebert Softball Scholarship**

Scholarship Amount is \$500.00. This is an annual 1x per year scholarship awarded to one biological female applicant for \$500.00. Applicant must be a senior currently playing high school softball and pursuing a post-high school education that involves continued play in the sport at the college/university level.

Date when Scholarship is due: April 1

The Randy Rebert Softball Scholarship is created in memory of Coach Randy and his passion for girls softball. Randy began his coaching career with his daughter, Veronica, in a local rec league and continued to coach rec league ball until 2020. He also coached high school softball at both the Junior Varsity and Varsity levels for 12 years after his daughter's graduation. Randy coached travel ball for several organizations and also created/managed his own travel ball team. His impact reached across the tri-county area of York – Adams – Lancaster Counties. Several girls Randy coached continued their softball career to the college level.

Randy believed softball helped make girls strong not just physically but mentally. He loved the challenge of the game and the discipline involved not just to play but also to win. His favorite go-to line whenever he went to the pitcher's mound during a game was "Where are we going for dinner after the game?". It was his effort to lighten tense moments and get everyone to refocus.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Age/Grade Level: York County graduating senior who has a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.

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Financial Need: Required

School: Any York County school graduating senior

College: Must be admitted to an accredited 2- or 4-year college or university as a full-time student and continue play in the sport for the entire academic year

Athletics: One \$500.00 scholarship to a biological female softball player per year

## **Application Details:**

Judging Criteria: Selection is based on high character, good work ethic, community participation, leadership qualities, a demonstrated spirit of caring towards others, and financial need.

Transcript: Submit a certified copy of high school transcript demonstrating a cumulative minimum weighted GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Resume/Activity List: Extracurricular activities, volunteerism, and leadership ship roles

Essay: A typed essay, not to exceed 300 words, stating why you feel you should be considered for this scholarship and what you love about the game.

Other Materials: ACT or SAT scores, Completed College Costs Estimator form, college acceptance letter, and one high-quality color headshot (shoulders and up). A professional senior photo is preferred.

**Recommendation Letters:** Two letters of recommendation. Recommendations may not be written by family members, school administrators or guidance counselors.

**NOTE:** If ANY of the required forms are not included (or an explanation provided as to why not), the application is considered incomplete and will not be considered.
